He agreed to fulfil concerns on the preparation of a project to be submitted to the European Union for financial support. The project was outlined in the **Trento workshop held in December 2017.** The provisional title of the project is **European alternatives and perspectives. Institutional variety, crisis and remedies.** 

Around these ideas and in agreement with the colleagues of DICE, and in particular with its Director, Dr. Miklós Rosta, he contributed to set up a group of colleagues from 11 European universities who are interested in the project. Then they proceeded to organize a workshop, held at Corvinus University on 28-29 March.
