

I warmly welcome you on behalf of the citizens of Corvinus University of Budapest. Our university is a market leading higher educational institution in Hungary in the academic fields of business and management, economics, and social sciences. Corvinus is an internationally recognized, prestigious Hungarian university, with over 300 partner institutions on 5 continents and memberships in some of the most elite international networks.

Corvinus' history dates back to the end of the 19th, beginning of the 20th century when the Eastern Commercial Academy (the forerunner of what is today Corvinus University) was established in 1899. Just as in other developed countries around the world, university-level education in the field of Economics was launched in 1920 at the Economics Faculty of the Hungarian Royal University of Science. In 1948, the

Hungarian University of Economics was established as a separate institution. Since then, the university has undergone a number of structural and name changes. Officially called Corvinus University of Budapest since 2004, it has, over the past 15 years experienced a number of major reorganizations.

Our University is currently undergoing a process of transformation. Previously a government-maintained higher educational institution, as of 1 July 2019, it has operated as a public-interest entity whose assets are managed by a trust foundation.

Our mission is to educate the social elite of the future. Our vision is to become the best university in Central and Eastern Europe in the fields of economics, business & management and social sciences in international higher education rankings by 2030. We aim to strengthen the international competitiveness of the university and to build closer academic ties with foreign partners.

We have realized that success in the global education market is possible only by thinking in international terms. In keeping with this, CUB wishes to increase the number of its quality English degree and training programs continuously, with special regard to training programs offered jointly with prestigious foreign partners. By 2030, Corvinus University wishes to raise the share of students in the degree programs where the medium of instruction is other than Hungarian (e.g. English) almost three-fold and strives to extend the share of foreign educators and researchers to 30% by 2030.

By meeting today's international higher education standards, we are aiming to

educate highly competitive graduates who are ready to enter global and local labor markets. To achieve this, we offer students from different cultures the opportunity to come together and learn from one another in the heart of Europe.





CHECK THE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The application and admission requirements vary depending on the chosen program so make sure to check the program specific requirements on the website. In the case of MA/MSc programs, the field in which the BA/BSc degree was obtained may influence whether or not the student can apply for the chosen program (prerequisite knowledge in a number of fields is mandatory in Hungary). Some programs stage written and/or oral exams, others require you to write an essay or to take part in an oral (webbased) interview. What you will need to provide for sure is a valid English language proficiency certificate. Native speakers and applicants who completed their bachelor and/or master level studies in English are exempt from this requirement as long as

they can present sufficient written proof).

SEND APPLICATION FORMS AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO THE STUDY OFFICE

Complete the application form on our website, attach copies of all necessary documents available at the time of application (missing documents can be submitted when they become available, and provide proof of payment of the application fee. All credentials and documents in a language other than English must be provided with a notarized translation. An authenticated, apostilled or diplomatically legalized (type of authentificaton depends on where the given diploma was issued) copy of the original diploma must be supplied to provide official proof of degree.

LEARN HOW TO APPLY FOR A STUDY VISA AND RESIDENCE PERMIT

Check the website of the Directorate-General for Aliens Policing or that of the Hungarian Consulate in your country to find out the application requirements for a visa/residence permit for the purpose of studies.



CORVINUS-MSM-SEED DOUBLE DEGREE EXECUTIVE MBA (EMBA)



The program welcomes young experts or early managerial talents who are at the general management level or have the potential to rise to this level. Ideal participants are open-minded, eager to learn and develop, proficient in English. and have 5 years of relevant work experience. This double degree program integrates the Central-Eastern-European regional expertise with international best practices and management experiences. The program focuses on the transition to general management. It covers the essential knowledge of all functional areas, prepares the participants for a leadership role and focuses on the mastery of 2 important skills: problem solving and team work. It is delivered by the cooperation of Corvinus University of Budapest, Maastricht School of Management and the School of Executive Education and Development. We had close cooperation with the leading regional companies in establishing the curriculum, courses are delivered by worldclass professors, genuine executives and (ex-)CEOs of the region. You will receive a unique combination of teaching methods, like Leadership Assessment, plenary and group discussions, teamwork, roleplays, case studies, peer feedback, quest speakers, personal coaching and mentoring and moreover, in company projects you will receive on-the-job learning through carefully selected topics. Present and future executives require not only general management knowledge, but also local connections to other regional business leaders and public officers as well as decision makers, ultimately a good network. It is the interests of both Central Eastern Europe and the EU to have a closer cooperation with China, to understand how the Chinese and the Asian economy are developing. Our specialised MBA program is ready to be your compass

and guide you in this multipolar world by the best professors of the East and West. With the professional support of Magyar Nemzeti Bank (the Central Bank of Hungary) the Chinese and Hungarian leading universities, Fudan University (OS TOP40, Shanahai) and Corvinus University of Budapest partnered to provide this Chinese-CEE double degree program. Corvinus Doctoral Schools

CORVINUS DOCTORAL SCHOOLS

There are altogether seven Doctoral Schools in our university which come together under the umbrella organization of Corvinus Doctoral Schools (CDS), allowing students in each doctoral school to take specific courses offered by other schools. In most cases, doctoral education lays the foundations of an international research/teaching career, it however also provides access to the theoretical and practical skills that are instrumental to leadership in business and public affairs.

The programs are only available on a fulltime basis. Although holding a full-time job while doing a PhD is completely lawful, it is not encouraged due to the quantity of compulsory classes, especially in the first two years of the four-year program. Admission criteria include the submission of a research plan to be approved by the prospective mentor/supervisor of each student. Supervisors are there to accompany the PhD candidate throughout his/her efforts to develop and finalize the doctoral dissertation as well as to help find publication outlets. The PhD defense is preceded by the defense of the thesis proposal, a public event that provides an excellent opportunity for receiving advice from a group of experts. When justified by the topic, supervision can be shared to include an external or foreign specialist.


JOINT EUROPEAN MASTER'S DEGREE IN COMPARATIVE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT

The Social Futuring Center (SFC) is a multidisciplinary research unit established to formulate and test the concept of "social futuring" and to exploit it in connection with the Social Futuring Index (SFI) within the framework of the ConNext 2050 project. The SFI has been designed to globally measure social entities' ability and readiness to embrace the future, and to manage future demographic, technological, economic, geopolitical, and other changes.

SFC started working in spring 2017, creating a convergent research hub that gathers researchers of integrative fields and combines the disciplinary approaches of philosophy, sociology, psychology, informatics, political science, network science and futures studies, among many others. So far, SFC has published numerous research papers in Hungarian and English, as well as a book and a special issue of the academic journal "Society & Economy" and also organized three international workshops and an international conference beside more than seven Hungarian academic events.

You may take part in various sport events such as the joint jogging around Margit Island, the Beerpong Championships or the Közgáz League, which is the official five-a-side football competition of Corvinus! A further opportunity for physical activity is the Corvinus Sport Week, organized once each semester.
