

EFOP-3.6.3-VEKOP-16-2017-00007 "Young researchers from talented students" project aimed at activities fostering scientific careers in higher education

Call for application for establishing research team Academic year 2020/21

Within the framework of EFOP 3.6.3 project (Young researcher from talented students) the Doctoral School of Business and Management and the Doctoral School of Economics and Business Informatics of Corvinus University of Budapest concerned in this tender announce an application for establishing research teams led by young researchers. Research groups have to promote the involvement of PhD and MA students in research activities conducted at Corvinus respectively. It is the leader of the research team who is entitled to apply for the call with the aim of establishing research team. The period of the research activity should be **5 months**. After announcing the successful research team, PhD and MA students can apply for the positions within the framework of a scholarship.

Objective of the research team project:

Promotion of young researchers' research activity and promotion of instructors whose research activity contributes to their progress. The program makes it possible for PhD and MA students to spend more time on research, learn the required skills and get closer to the researcher profession.

Procedure of the decision of research team applications:

Application for research teams can be submitted by the research team. 1 PhD student and 1 MA student is expected to participate in a research team, their work plan has to be included in the research plan.

The leadership board of the Doctoral School decides on the research team applications by involving the subproject leader of the EFOP 3.6.3 project. Applicants will be notified via email by the project assistant and the list of winning research teams will be available on the website of the project as well (fiatalkutato.uni-corvinus.hu).

¹ Young researcher: Postdoctoral colleague of the university, who has not reached the age of 40 by the signing of the grant agreement.





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Those research proposals are preferred which/where:

- fit the research strategy of the university,
- can promote the academic progress of young researchers,
- can be continued after the completion of the funded research project,
- build upon the works and topics of previous EFOP research teams,
- results are expected to be published in qualified domestic or international journal(s).

For the student positions awarded to the successful research groups PhD and MA students can apply in the framework of "Doctoral Excellence Scholarship" and "Research Scholarship" via NEPTUN. The research team leader makes a recommendation regarding the rankings preferred by him/her. Decision is made by a dedicated Committee consisting of six members: the professional leader of the project EFOP 3.6.3 as chair, the three leaders of the sub-projects as members, the project manager and a member or representative from the doctoral school to which the winner research team belongs. About the Committee's decision and about the awarded students the research team leaders will be notified by the project assistant of the EFOP 3.6.3. project.

If there are not enough applications for the grant in the given doctoral school, the management of the project will decide on the reallocation of financed positions among the university's doctoral schools.

Application requirements for the position of research leader:

- 1. Active status of the participants during the whole research period
- 2. PhD degree and a classification of maximum habil. associate professor (Applications of young researchers are preferred)

Applications have to be sent by e-mail to Nóra Fazekas (project assistant) (nora.fazekas@uni-corvinus.hu) until the indicated deadline.

Application has to contain the following:

- 1. CV and publication list (including the major publications) of the leader of the research team
- 2. Research proposal
- 3. A signed copy of the declarations of the research team leader

Requirements of the research proposal:

The research proposal has to contain the following data:

- name of the research team
- name of doctoral school









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- research proposal: approx. 2 pages including the following:
 - o title of the research in English and in Hungarian
 - o research question
 - o scheduling of the research, description of assignment
 - o scheduling of publications in case of each participant

Publication requirements for the research team:

- 1. min. 1 article in a journal with A-C classification on the journal list of the relevant MTA committee
- 2. min. 1 scientific conference presentation
- 3. 1 TDK essay (in case of the MA student)

The deadline of publications' issue can exceed the (scholarship) period of the research team. Requirements have to be fulfilled within the accepted period by submitting at least the statement of acceptance.

Research team leader declares that he/she is ready to:

- supervise the working of the participants
- prepare a final report on the accomplished research activity
- fulfill the publication requirements.

Guide to the scholarship application of the PhD and MA students

PhD students have to submit the following documents via NEPTUN:

- application form and statement
- detailed CV (Europass)
- cover letter (max. 1 page)
- signed copy of the recommendation letter from a full professor / associate professor of the given research field



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• signed copy of the recommendation letter from the applicant's supervisor (who can be the research team leader as well)²

MA students have to submit the following documents via NEPTUN:

- application form and statement
- detailed CV (Europass)
- cover letter (max. 1 page)
- signed copy of the recommendation letter from the research team leader



² In case the research team leader recommends the PhD student, he/she can do that either as the student's supervisor or as the full professor / associate professor of the given research field. That is, the research team leader can give one recommendation per person.
