The principal part of the exam has three equally important pillars: (1) getting to be acquainted with the applicant's motivations and attitude; (2) gaining impressions on the applicant's ability to express professional arguments and considerations – in the case of the entrance exam of the English language master's programme: gaining impressions on the applicant's ability to express him/herself in English; (3) assessment of the applicant's proficiency in the field of environmental and regional economics, regional development, environmental and climate policies.
