

Call for Applications

**Good Student, Good Athlete Scholarship
for the Academic Year of 2020/2021**

Corvinus University of Budapest (hereinafter referred to as “University”) calls for applications for a Good Student, Good Athlete Scholarship for the 2020/2021 academic year in accordance with 34 § of the Corvinus SZMR Volume III Part 4 on Student Compensation and Allowance Regulation (HTJSZ). The Good Student, Good Athlete Scholarship is a one-time lump sum financial allowance per academic year to encourage and support good results and outstanding sports activities. The aim of the scholarship is to support students who have achieved excellent results in both their studies and sports.

1. The scholarship is available for students pursuing bachelor's, master's or single cycle studies and have an active student status in the 1st (autumn) and 2nd (spring) semesters of the 2020/2021 academic year.

2. Conditions of application:

Only the following students may be eligible for the scholarship:

- a) that have an active student status at the time of submitting the application;
- b) that have a credit-weighted average of at least 3.5 for both semesters in the 2020/2021 academic year;
- c) had obtained at least 23 credits in each semester completed during his/her studies,
- d) the training period does not exceed 1.5 times more the training period specified in the training and outcome requirements.
- e) achieved outstanding results in sports competitions between 10 June 2020 and 10 June 2021.

Sports criteria: In the period from 10 June 2020 to 10 June 2021, participation in any type of sport is acceptable, that primarily covers national championship, European championship, world championship Olympic medals are awarded, but university medals are also acceptable. It is possible to apply with results achieved in a team or individually.

3. Applications shall be submitted through the Neptun system under “Administration/Requests/Available Request Forms by filling in the relevant information in form “Good Student, Good Athlete 2020/2021” and uploading the required documents and certificates by the application deadline.

4. Application submission period:

7 June 2021 10:00 AM - 15 June 2021 12:00 PM (noon).

5. Documents accompanying the application form shall be uploaded in PDF format, the individual size of which may not exceed 500 kB. The application cannot be submitted until all documents are uploaded.

6. When assessing the applications, a detailed evaluation of the study results and the sporting activity will be weighed as follows (detailed guidance can be found in the annex to this call):

- a) A maximum of 1100 points may be awarded as Study points:
a maximum of 1100 points can be obtained on the basis of the two-semester credit-weighted study average of the 2020/2021 academic year. (score value = two-semester credit-weighted study average x 220).
- b) A maximum of 1100 points may be awarded for Sports activities:
aa) the detailed scoring is set out in the annex,

- ba) only one competition, most favourable to the applicant, shall be taken into account for sporting activities.
7. The review and prioritisation of applications shall be carried out by the Sports Committee.
 - a) The Sports Committee shall examine the authenticity of the certificate and may request the original of the certificate from the applicant.
 - b) False, incorrect or incomplete applications shall be rejected.
 8. The Sports Committee shall review and prioritise the applications within one week of the deadline for submission.
 9. The Vice-rector of Education shall make the final decision on the granting of the scholarship.
 10. Rewarding:
 - a) The total budget of the scholarship is HUF 300 000. The number of students eligible for the scholarship is 3.
 - I. Place scholarship: HUF 120 000
 - II. Place scholarship: HUF 100 000
 - III. Place scholarship: HUF 80 000
 - b) The winner of the application is also the defender of the "Good Student - Athlete" cup founded by the Physical Education Sports Center for one year.
 - c) Students in places 1-6. shall receive a memorial certificate.
 11. Appeals must be submitted through Neptun to the Student Appeals Committee within 15 days of the date of communication.

Appendix:

1. Evaluation of academic achievement (maximum 1100 points):

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- a) The study average weighted by the credits defined in 34 § (3) of the TVSZ shall be used:
 - Credit-weighted study average = $\sum(\text{credit point} \times \text{grade}) / \text{completed credit point}$.
- b) The credit-weighted average will be calculated on the basis of the results of all the courses enrolled in the semester(s) concerned
 - i) Grades accomplished based on another (parallel) student status established in another higher education institution and obtained in such parallel courses cannot be included in the calculation of the scholarship average.
 - ii) The subjects closed with fail or with a "missed exam", "no show" entry are included with zero mark in the formula, to which an exception is, if the student in the course of improving a successful examination does not attend the examination in the given subject and receives a "no show" entry, in which case the last successful grade and credit value of the given subject is indicated in the calculation.
 - iii) Relating to students pursuing their higher education at the master's level, in addition to credits required to obtain a diploma being a mandatory condition of the application, the subjects to be completed parallel with the training aimed at obtaining a master's level degree, are not included in the credit weighted study average, under the preliminary credit acknowledgement process and including the credits completed in previous studies.
 - iv) Subjects completed in the framework of the guest student status, regardless of whether the student has completed them in the framework of the guest student relationship established with a domestic or foreign higher education institution, shall be deemed to have been completed by the student at the University and the results thereof shall be included in the credit-weighted study average and grades accepted by the Credit Transfer Committee.

2. Detailed assessment of sport activities (maximum 1100 points):
