

## Vaccine registration for international students in Hungary

Based on Government Decree 18/1998. (VI. 3.) NM the Hungarian Government has made COVID vaccination available – further to those who already possess a TAJ card – also for foreign nationals (including students) already living in Hungary for over 3 months who do not, as yet possess one.

### Who is eligible to receive the COVID vaccine in Hungary free of charge:

- All non-Hungarian nationals residing in Hungary for over 90 days within a 180-day period.

### What will you need to register for the COVID vaccination?

#### **If you have a TAJ number:**

*(All details given below are mandatory)*

- Name
- E-mail address
- Phone number
- Age
- TAJ number
- Address (for receiving the vaccination card)

#### **If you do not have a TAJ number(EU/EEA nationals, please check the footnote!)**

*(Residence Permit & Passport details are mandatory)*

- Name
- Age
- Contact details (e-mail and phone number)
- Residence Permit number **or** Hungarian National ID card number
- Personal ID number (from Address card) **or** Passport Number
- Address (for receiving the vaccination certificate)

<sup>1</sup> Please note: European Union and European Economic Area nationals are currently unable register for the vaccination due to a technical error on the registration website. The registration requires a valid residence permit with a 9-digit number, and the EU registration

card only has an 8-digit number. If this affects you, please keep checking the registration website for any updates or email the authorities directly.

### **How to register:**

1. To register for the vaccine please visit: [Vakcinainfó \(gov.hu\)](https://vakcinainfo.gov.hu)
2. Fill out your details and indicate whether or not you have a TAJ card.  
If you have a TAJ card (or have already received your TAJ number, but not the card): please give the TAJ number.  
If you do not have a TAJ card, please indicate whether you are a Hungarian citizen and fill out as many details as possible.
3. Please only fill out the address section with an address you have access to and can receive postal mail to. Your vaccination card will be mailed to the address you give.
4. Accept the Privacy Policy and Data Processing consent section.
5. If the yellow Register button appears grey, please recheck your details for corrections or add further document numbers.
6. Click on the yellow Register button.

Unfortunately, we do not know, nor can we predict a) when you will receive notice to get the vaccine after registration, b) nor the type of vaccine you will be offered. You will be informed of this by e-mail or in a text message to your phone, so please keep checking your email and phone number provided during registration for any updates. By registering, you are not obliged to accept the type of vaccination you are offered, however, when you will next be offered an opportunity rests with the relevant healthcare authorities.
