

**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS**  
**for CUB’s “Publication Grant”**

from grant resource EFOP-3.6.3-VEKOP-16-2017-00007

Within the framework of the EFOP-3.6.3-VEKOP-16-2017-00007 „Young researchers from talented students” project aimed at activities fostering scientific careers in higher education the Corvinus University of Budapest hereby invites applications for grants (hereinafter referred to as grant) from doctoral students and doctoral candidates.

- (1) The aim of the grant is to help increase the number of domestic and international, Hungarian and foreign language publications authored by doctoral students and former students preparing to submit their doctoral dissertation (hereinafter students), to support convergence with international research trends. The publication grant supports students in obtaining their publication credits that are mandatorily prescribed in the new type of doctoral education and thus contributes to meeting requirements and successfully completing the doctoral program.
- (2/A) Eligibility for the present grant is limited to students who meet their publication commitments between 01-07-2020 and 31-05-2022 with the following conditions:
  - a. only peer-reviewed scientific publications will be accepted as publications in the call,
  - b. publications may be Hungarian or foreign language titles, articles or publications issued in domestic or international journals, specialized journals, peer-reviewed publications
  - c. publications issued in printed and electronic journals as well as co-authored publications are eligible, however only one author may receive support for the same publication
  - d. beneficiaries of the grant undertake to feature in the finished publication that they have completed the publication in the framework of CUB’s EFOP-3.6.3-VEKOP-16-2017-00007 project and to send the finished publications or their access information – in the case of foreign language publications, a Hungarian abstract is also to be provided to the project management team.
  - e. Publications linked to so-called predatory journals (source: MTMT /Hungarian Scientific Works Database (hereinafter referred to as MTMT/ classification of journals or Beall list: <https://beallslist.net/>) are not eligible.
  - f. Publications that have received support from another grant source are not eligible.
- (2/B) Criteria for meeting publication commitments:
  - a. only those publications can be supported that are approved in MTMT and assigned to the Corvinus University of Budapest and meet the criteria laid down in section (2/A) above; and the publication features the fact that it was completed in the framework of CUB’s EFOP-3.6.3-VEKOP-16-2017-00007<sup>1</sup> project; and

- b. the finished publication or its access information – in the case of foreign language publications, a Hungarian abstract is also to be provided – is sent to the project management team upon appearance.
- (3) Application criteria:  
Application is open for **doctoral students** or **doctoral candidates** with an active status in the doctoral programme, furthermore former students who have already obtained their absolorium but have not yet submitted their doctoral dissertation.
- (4) Application procedure:
- Completed applications shall be sent to the project management team of EFOP-3.6.3-VEKOP-16-2017-00007 electronically to the e-mail address [katalin.kovacs@uni-corvinus.hu](mailto:katalin.kovacs@uni-corvinus.hu) The following shall be attached:
    - completed application form and declarations,
    - certificate of student status OR certifications about the absolorium and the current state of dissertation submission
    - accepted publication in pdf format,
    - official signed editorial declaration of acceptance.
  - Incomplete applications shall not be accepted, the Evaluation Board refuses it without any substantive examination
  - Application period: 01-07-2020 – 15-05-2022.
  - Applications are welcome on a continuous basis until the global budget of the grant is depleted.
- (5) Amount and source of the grant:
- Amount of the grant:
    - for publications in Hungarian HUF 50,000 gross/ publication/student
    - for publications in a foreign language HUF 100,000 gross/publication/student.
  - Available grant budget: HUF 6,150,000

The support is a one-off, single amount that is paid in case the student fulfilled the conditions undertaken in the assignment contract and in section (2) above, within 30 days of the issuance of the certificate of performance.

- (6) Applications are assessed by an Evaluation Board which convenes until the 8th day of each month. The chairperson of the Evaluation Board shall be the professional manager of the EFOP-3.6.3-VEKOP-16-2017-00007 project. Its members shall be the managers of the three subprojects of EFOP-3.6.3-VEKOP-16-2017-00007, the project manager of EFOP-3.6.3-VEKOP-16-2017-00007 as well as the Head of the relevant doctoral school or a person delegated by him/her. The Evaluation Board shall decide on the

applications submitted during the previous month in their order of submission. The Board shall make it decision with a view to the viability of the project.

- (7) Publication of the results:
- The Evaluation Board shall inform applicants on the outcome in a letter sent to the electronic address provided on the application form.
  - The payment of the grant is due after the issuing of a completion certificate that is subject to the criteria set out in Article 2/b of the call for application.
