The leadership of Corvinus University of Budapest decided to establish the Corvinus Institute for Advanced Studies – Central Europe in Global Context (CIAS) with the aims to reach a higher level of the University's research performance and significantly improve its international potential in 2018.

It provides scholars having outstanding credentials with research fellowships in the following grant categories:

- ▶ invited distinguished research fellow,
- ▶ senior research fellow,
- ▶ junior research fellow,
- ▶ non-resident research fellow.

The fundamental goal is to create an inspiring and creative academic community. Scholarships are granted in a process based on calls for application. This contributes to CIAS' own intellectual profile in harmony with the strategic goals of Budapest, Hungary and Central Europe.

THE WORKING LANGUAGE IS ENGLISH.

The application process is managed by CIAS. Grants are made for citizens of any country for a variety of research and educational activities (primarily advanced research and PhD teaching).

Most grants are awarded for a period of one or two semesters (5 or 10 months) and in special circumstances it may be extended for limited periods.
