Halvel

Information on Corvinus's lecturer
and course evaluation system

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General information

HalVel provides students with the opportunity to give personal feedback on their completed courses and their professors based on their experiences during the semester – in a way that ensures their anonymity. This is an important part of the university's quality assurance and development system, as students are the “customers” in the field of education. Of course, the development of programs is a complex process, which includes the application of international trends, best practices, expectations and feedback from the labor market and many other factors. Because of these, student feedback may not necessarily result in any changes.

HalVel not only works on a collective level. By providing objective (positive and negative, as appropriate) feedback you can also assist professors identify the areas where they can improve their individual performance. By completing HalVel you can, in effect, contribute to the development of your lecturers, the content of and their way of teaching the subject, which ultimately, may lead to fellow students studying the subject in later semesters to benefit from the practices you consider to be good or to avoid the consequences of practices you consider to be improvable.

HalVel is a questionnaire, which is voluntary and anonymous, and can be filled out during a given period of time at the end of the semester.

Individual benefits of filling out halvel

As an incentive for student participation in HalVel, the university created an opportunity for students completing the questionnaire to register – in the semester following the completion of HalVel – for their exams sooner (e.g., if you fill it in spring semester, you can register sooner for your exams in the autumn semester). This is an added incentive for you, as it will allow you to register for your exams 1 week before the official exam registration period opens in Neptun, and thus may assist you in registering for your exams in keeping with the schedule you have planned.

Not filling out the HalVel does not mean that you will not be able to register for your exams as foreseen, but in some cases, you may possibly miss out on an exam date and have to take the exam at a later date.

Further to the above, HalVel can help you improve your critical thinking, self-knowledge, and ability to form opinions and communicate them objectively. This will be useful for you not only later on in your work, but also in many other fields of life.

How halvel works

You can access HalVel via the halvel.uni-corvinus.hu page, which you can access with your own Cusman ID and password (ie. what you use to access Moodle).

You have the opportunity to evaluate the ...

- ... subjects you have studied in the given semester.
- ... the performance of professors who taught you in the given semester.
- ... the quality of the study administration for the given semester.

In addition, during the evaluation you have the opportunity to indicate, on the basis of your own declaration, the extent to which you participated in the sessions of a given subject and roughly how much time you spent on completing them.

You can also check the ...

- ... quantitative evaluations of professors from previous semesters, detailed by semester and in aggregated form.
- ... quantitative evaluations of subjects in previous semesters, detailed by semester and in aggregated form.

This can help you in subsequent semesters to choose subjects and professors that you feel will best serve your development during your studies.

The results can be accessed via the RESULTS section of the website, where you can choose which semester data you want to check. Then you can browse the evaluations of the professors and subjects in the GENERAL menu item, and you can also view the evaluations of your subjects and their lecturers in a separate menu item.

When filling the HalVel (evaluation of courses and professors) we request that you be objective and avoid being offensive in any way. While HALVEL ensures total anonymity for you, the results of your feedback can have long-term consequences for the professors. Be honest, but stick to the truth. If you feel that you have been mistreated in any way during your studies, please feel free to contact the relevant university leaders through the complaint reporting system any time during the semester.
