

Deadlines, important dates


9-22 November 2022 (11:59 am)	The MOB system is open from 9th to 22nd (the application can be modified at any time until submission)
December 2022 - February 2023	Evaluation of submitted applications, scoring
February 2022	Publication of scores on the website
February 2022	Period of appeal
March 2022	Allocation of partner universities
March 2022	Official appeal period
March 2022	Announcement of remaining places, call for application

ERASMUS+ PARTIAL TRAINING

The Socrates program, known as the European Union's education support program, has continued since 2007 under the Lifelong Learning Program. It had four sub-programs: Comenius (public education), Erasmus (higher education), Leonardo (vocational training, except at tertiary level) and Grundtvig (adult education). These support programs and the youth and sports programs have been merged by the European Union under the Erasmus + program, which will start in 2014.

The choice of name is not a coincidence, as Erasmus is considered one of the most successful projects in the EU. Interestingly, the American magazine TIME ranked Erasmus among the 20 most significant achievements of the European Union on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the Rome Convention.

Who can apply?

- ***Applications for the autumn and spring semester 2023/2024***
- Applications are will be open for all three bachelor
- You can apply for both years of the Master's programme, even in the last semester of the Bachelor's programme, if you plan to apply for a Master's degree at Corvinus
- Students enrolled in the first two years of doctoral studies, or students who have not completed their doctoral degree may also apply



Basic application conditions and information

- You may choose maximum 10 universities from our partner institution list
- Max. 12 months per training cycle (you can apply twice during your studies)
 - - studies: 3-12 months, internship: 2-12 months
 - - extension is possible within the academic year, but it is not guaranteed (submit extension request by 30 November)
- Set active status (before departure) + register for the „Semester Abroad" subject
- Eligibility for tuition fee waiver at the partner institution (but tuition fees must be paid at Corvinus)
- Minimum 3,00 GPA
- Credit transfer is compulsory – affects your GPA

Application elements

- **Online application:** following your registration in CUB's MOBility Manager system
- Copies of documents proving **language proficiency** must be uploaded into MOB (it is not enough to have the language certificate details in the Neptun system)
- **Other proofs:** professional activity, community work
- **Motivation letter:** for the first 3 places indicated, in the given motivation letter template, which can be downloaded from the MOB system
- **Online form provided by the MOB:** for previous (2021-22 or earlier) student organisation activity, the template provided must be completed via the MOB (e.g.: Student Organisation Membership, Demonstration Activity Certificate)

Application procedure

- **MOB registration:** Mobility Manager - Student ==- [Corvinus University of Budapest]
- - fill in with correct data
- - check the order of the institutions (max. 10 will be taken into account), copy the application form data for later review
- - the **MOB will save the data** so that you can continue your application anytime, until the deadline
- - it is **NOT possible to change the order of the institutions or any data** in any way **after** the application has been **submitted**
- Documents to be uploaded: language certificate(s), other professional activity + Credit certificate from Neptun: information general forms **credit certificate**
- - Only **language certificates uploaded into the MOB system** will be taken into account
- - Maximum upload size per file: **2 MB**
- **Filling in the form** created by the Students' Union:
student organisation activities
- After verification, finalise your application by clicking on the "Submit application" button

Selection of institution

- **Mobility period:** autumn and/or spring 2023/24

- by destination country and institution: approach, language, livelihood, prices
- **Field of education**
- How relevant to your studies? - **First five universities you** apply for should be your **own discipline**

The institution may also have specific requirements:

Language skills: responsibility of the applicant; information on language skills can be found on the partner university's website and in the 'comment' section of Mobility.

Grants for **BILATERAL** places up to the amount available

- 1. Bentley University, University of Richmond, University of Michigan- Ross Business School (US)**
- 2. CEMS students** - the first 10 students with the highest scores, who applied for a bilateral place, will be selected.
- 3. DD programme participants** - minimum 4 cumulative adjusted credit index of the students
- 4. Great Britain:** Students with a cumulative adjusted credit index of at least 4,5 will be awarded a grant
- 5.** The remaining amount will be awarded to all other students who applied for a bilateral place, on the basis of the students' score.

Scholarships for BILATERAL places

Mobility to partner countries	700 Euro/ month
(except regions 5 and 14)	plus travel allowance

- Except for Switzerland and the United Kingdom.

What do I need to check before applying and then leaving?

- Choosing carefully: <https://corvinus.mobilitymanager.hu/intezmenyek/>?
- **Parts of the application, scoring, deadlines**
- Subjects to be taken (**min. 30 credits**/6 subjects)
- Other requirements (**language exams**, prerequisites)
- Operational curriculum in this country - for subject admission
- Study Abroad Regulations (available on the website: "Documents important for preparing your trip")
