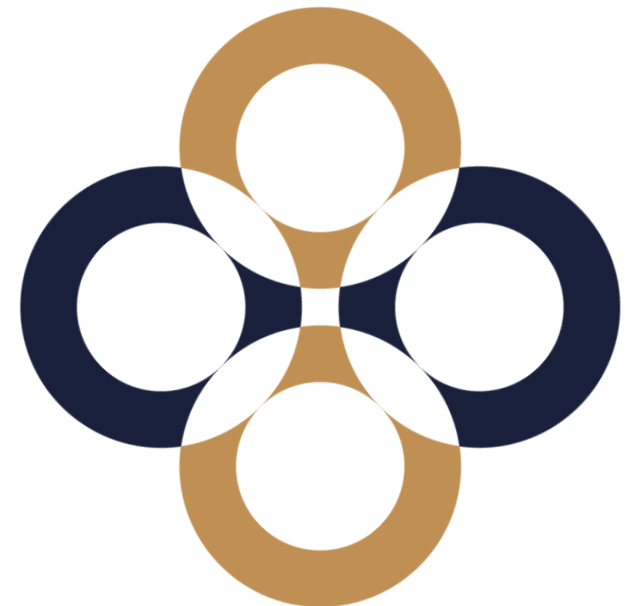

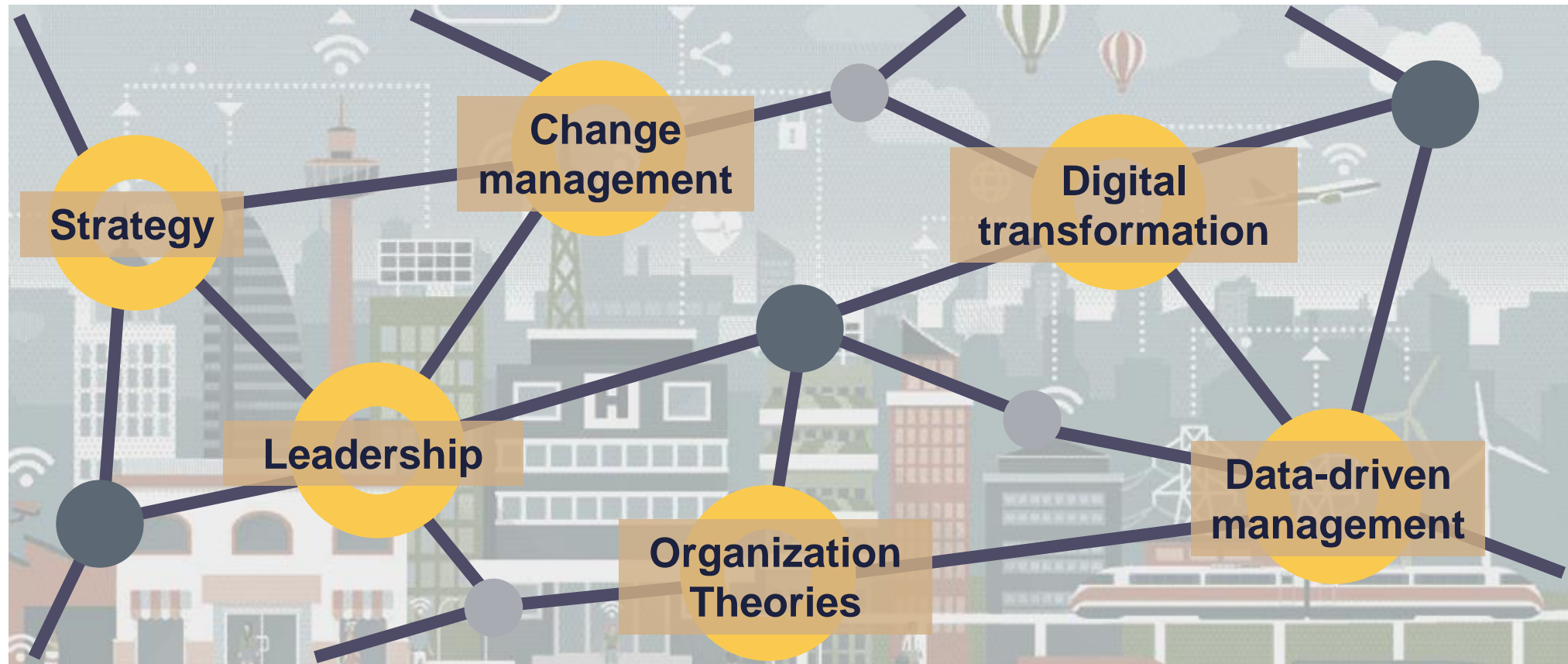
Program structure: MiML in English (with CEMS)

Corvinus MiML program: mission and vision

Our mission is to provide students with a leadership perspective that serves as a basis for future leadership positions, while preparing them to perform innovatively and responsibly in internal and external management functions and advisory roles.

Our graduates will be able to:

- perceive and present organisational phenomenon from a holistic perspective as a system thinker,
- identify and analyse organisational issues, formulate new solutions (creatively design new organisational and management processes and practices),
- operate and manage systems and processes with autonomy, courage and participation,
- lead teams or change processes while engaging and empowering others



Attractive career positions for fresh graduates



- Consultant at top international strategy and management consulting firms
- Business developer, analyst or controlling specialist in leading multinational or regional corporations
- Innovation or technology-focused project/process manager, often in a multicultural environment
- Typical sectors of activity: consulting, IT/telecom, financial services, FMCG, healthcare, energy



Admission to MiML in English

- **English language exam from the list:** TOEFL iBT100; IELTS 7.0; CPE C; CAE B; BEC Higher B; PTE 68; Corvinus Oeconom C1
 - Exemptions: a Bachelor’s diploma entirely taught in English from an English-speaking country or in a CEMS or EQUIS/ AACSB-accredited institution or English as the mother tongue
- **Competence Test** (does not count towards the admission score)
- **Written exam in Business Economics** (max. 30 points for Felvi.hu applicants, 60 points for applicants of the institutional admission)
 - Exemptions: BA or BSc from an AACSB, AMBA, EQUIS (EFPD) or EAPAA accredited faculty/university or accredited program with a final (average) grade of “B” (or equivalent) or GMAT with minimum 600 points (average across verbal and quantitative measures) or GRE with minimum 155 points (average across verbal and quantitative measures).
- **Oral exam (admission interview):** problem solving exercise and motivational interview (max. 40 points)
 - No exemptions: This oral exam is compulsory for all applicants!
- **Note:** Students applying to both the English and the Hungarian programs are required to attend both the English and the Hungarian exams!

Prospects

- The admission process is highly selective (as CEMS admission as well).
- The number of students (Felvi + international) will be limited to 20-30.
- Corvinus scholarship available for EEA applicants; self-funded fee is HUF 970,000 or EUR 3600 per semester)



Bologna-rule: except students with BBA (business/management) degrees, credit acceptance is required

- Altogether 60 ECTS from five study areas are required:
 - mathematics, statistics, informatics (15 ECTS)
 - economics (10 ECTS)
 - business economics, accounting, finance, marketing etc. (15 ECTS)
 - social sciences (10 ECTS)
 - management, organizational behavior/HR, strategic/business planning, operations management, controlling etc. (10 ECTS)
- **Solid business studies background** (including accounting, finance and management knowledge) is key for the successful CEMS application (MiML in English).
- Some of the missing ECTS credits can be completed during the first year of the program. Credit acceptance usually fails when more than 3 courses are to be completed that way.
