

ELECTRONIC RESOURCES

The Library provides the most important national and international journals, business and statistical databases in the fields of economics, business and in social sciences related to the courses.

Scientific contents produced at the University is published in four digital repositories. These are open to the public with the exception of Corvinus TDK where the full-text is only accessible from the university's network.

Using 'SuperSearch' you can search in multiple databases and other scholarly sources at the same time. The individual browsing of databases is facilitated by a brief description of their contents and subjects lists.

The 'E-book/Journal search' contains subscribed and OA full text journals and e-books in Hungarian and foreign languages.

Electronic content can be accessed remotely by Corvinus community via VPN and/or EduID. Registered external readers can use subscribed electronic contents on the premises of the Library.

SERVICES, COLLECTIONS

The Library's print holding contains over 400,000 volumes of books, dissertations, manuscripts and textbooks, including the most recent works, as well as masterpieces of the 18th-20th century Hungarian and foreign economic literature.

The print collection is searchable in SuperSearch and also in the Catalogue. Books can be borrowed by using self-checkout. Loan periods can be prolonged online after logging into the Catalogue.

To support academic success and researchers' publication excellence, the Library organizes training sessions, as well as, consultations for groups and individuals. More information is available on the Writing Center site.

The Library gives opportunity for in-depth, individual study and also collaborative learning, group work. Consultation rooms for 4-6 people can be booked online for students and faculty members.
