The leadership of Corvinus University of Budapest decided to establish the Corvinus Institute for Advanced Studies – Central Europe in a Global Context (CIAS) in 2018 with the aims of reaching a higher level research performance at the university and improving significantly its internatonal potential.

It provides research fellowship grant opportunities to scholars with outstanding credentials in the following grant categories:

- invited distinguished research fellow,
- ► senior research fellow,
- ▶ junior research fellow,
- non-resident research fellow.

The fundamental goal is to create an inspiring and creative academic community, which contributes to CIAS' own intellectual profile in harmony with the strategic goals of Corvinus, Budapest, Hungary and Central Europe.

The application process is managed by CIAS. Grants are made for citizens of any country for a variety of research and educational activities (primarily advanced research, related PhD-level lecturing and mentoring). Most grants are awarded for a period of one or two semesters (5 or 10 months) and in special circumstances they may be extended for limited periods.



CIAS HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED CLOSELY RELATED TO RESEARCH TOPICS OF THE FOUR DOCTORAL SCHOOLS OF THE UNIVERSITY:

- Doctoral School of Business and Management,
- ▶ Doctoral School of Economics, Business and Informatics,
