4. ACCESS TO DATA AND TRANSFER OF DATA

The University will only disclose data to third parties on the basis of a legal authorisation or with the consent of the data subject.

6. DATA SECURITY MEASURES

Once the application is submitted, the University stores personal data on the University servers. The University shall take appropriate measures to ensure that personal data are protected against, inter alia, unauthorised access, and to ensure the continued confidentiality, integrity, availability and resilience of the systems and services used to process personal data, and the ability to restore in a timely manner access to and availability of personal data in the event of a physical or technical incident.

7. RIGHTS IN RELATION TO DATA PROCESSING

The data subject has the right to request information about the data processing, the right to obtain rectification of data, the right to obtain blocking (restriction of data processing) as well as to request the data processor to provide him/her information on his/her personal data and information relating to the processing thereof. The data subject may request the porting of his/her data if the conditions laid down in Article 20 of the GDPR are met. The data subject may withdraw his/her consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the data processing that took place before the withdrawal. Withdrawal of consent will mutatis mutatis mutandis imply the end of the application process. The data subject may request the erasure of his/her data if the conditions laid down in Article 17 of the GDPR are met. 8. LEGAL ENFORCEMENT IN RELATION TO DATA PROCESSING

In the event of unlawful data processing, the data subject may refer the matter to the CORVINUS Data Protection Officer, the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (NAIH) or a court.
