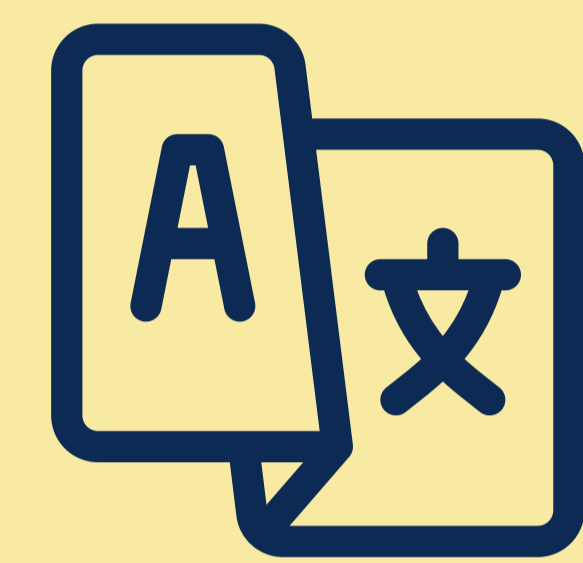

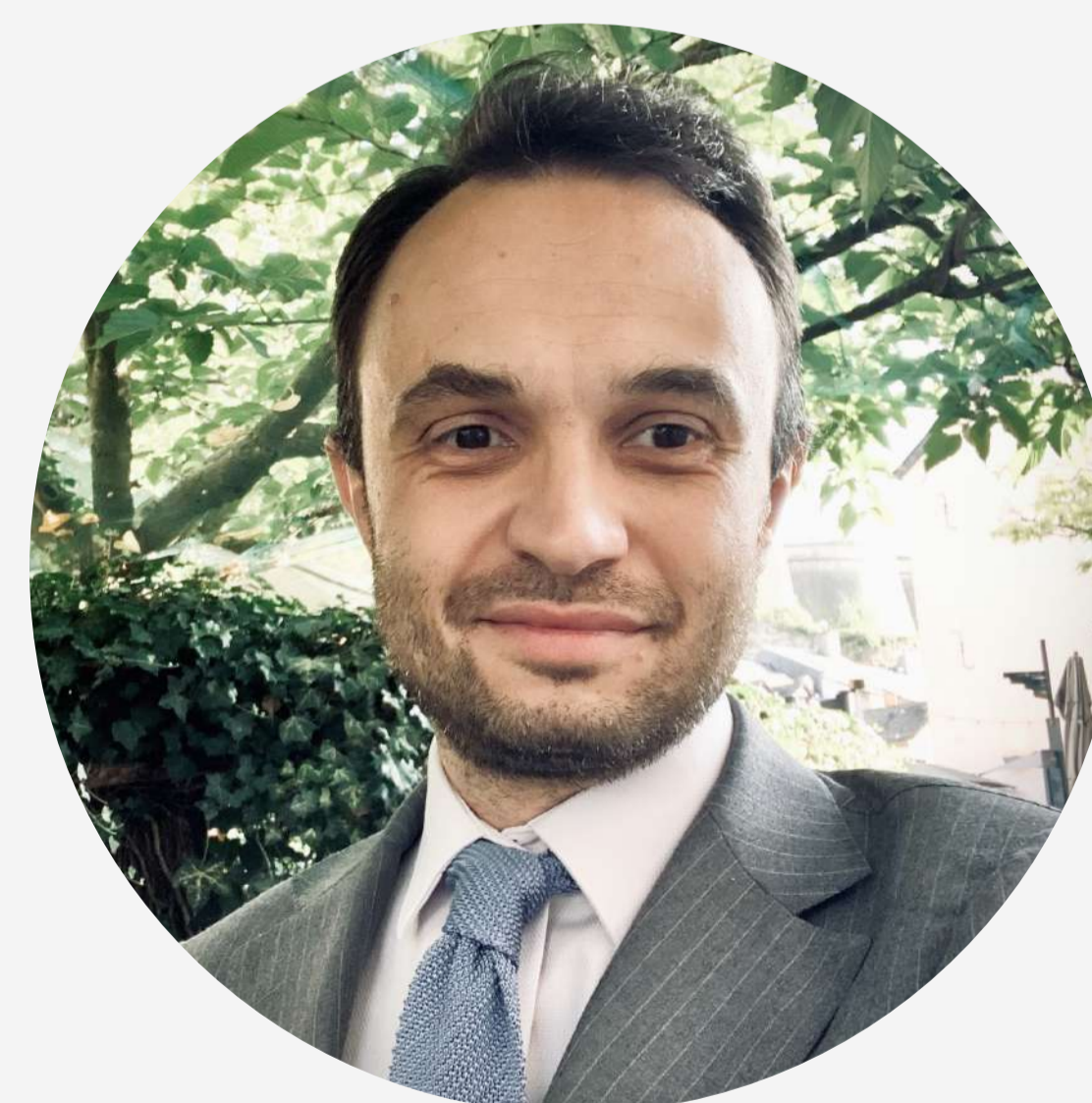

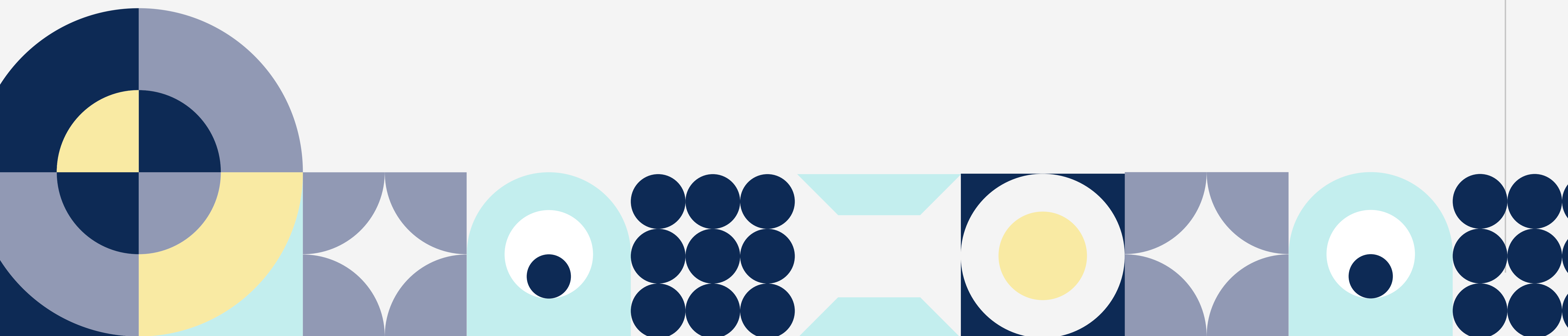

✓ How many courses can I choose?

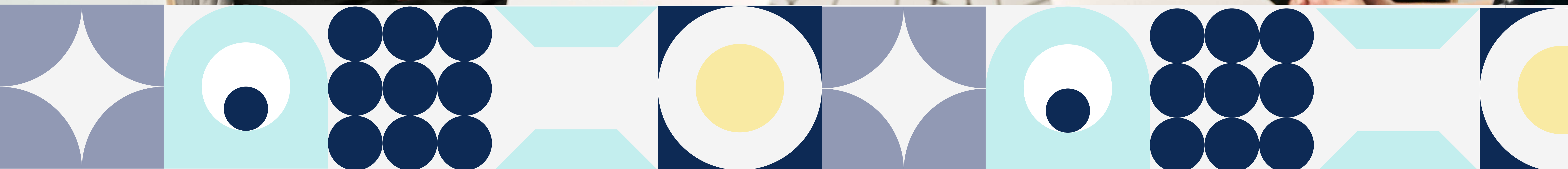
Students choose two out of three courses to participate in.

Extra activities include a visit to the National Park Krka and the coastal city of Šibenik, and a company visit.



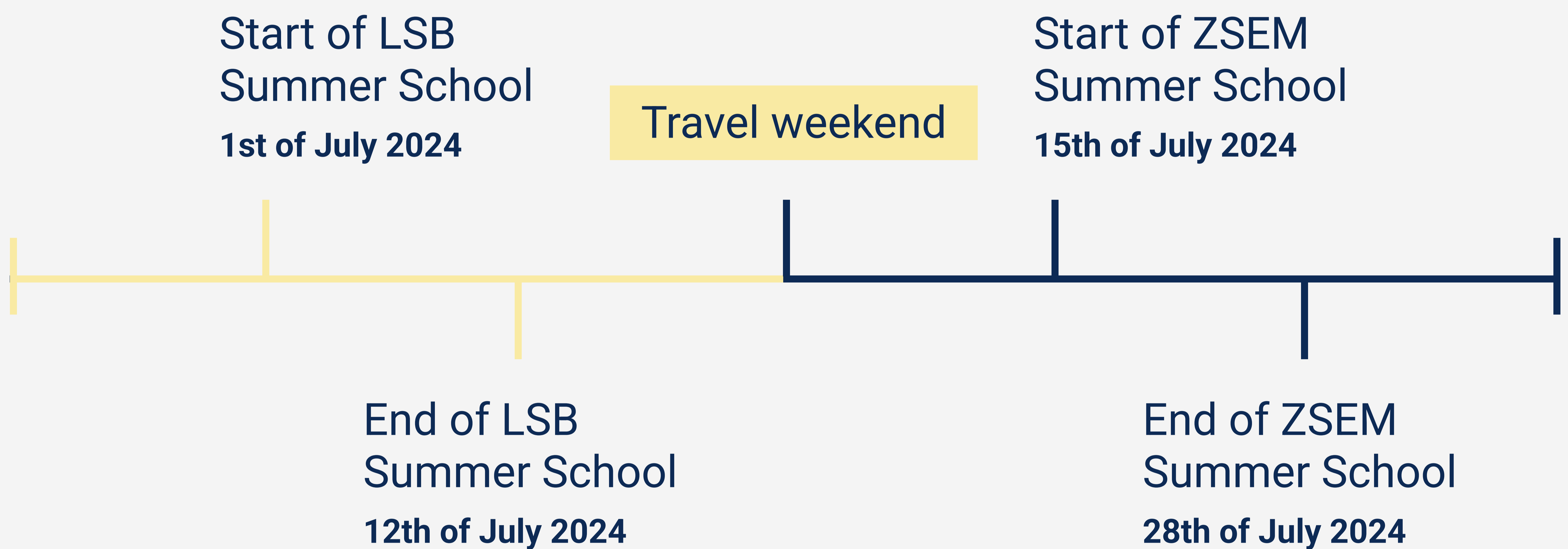
