

Gym Usage Rules

Ráday Dormitory

Dear Residents,

The gym at BCE Ráday Dormitory operates as a private club. To ensure a safe and pleasant environment for everyone, please follow the rules below. By using the gym, you automatically accept these rules.

1. Payment and Registration

- 1.1. All gym users (hereinafter “users”) are registered in the dormitory’s records.
- 1.2. By submitting the gym usage declaration, the user accepts these rules and acknowledges that compliance may be monitored by dormitory staff.
- 1.3. Personal data will be used solely for internal records and will not be shared with third parties.
- 1.4. The gym may only be used in a healthy physical condition.
- 1.5. The usage fee must be paid via the Neptun system.
- 1.6. Only authorised BCE Ráday Dormitory residents may use the gym; visitors are not allowed.
- 1.7. Entry is by access card, and a valid photo ID must be presented to dormitory staff or the porter if requested.
- 1.8. Allowing unauthorised persons to enter the gym may result in suspension of the user’s gym privileges.

2. Prohibited in the Gym

- 2.1. Smoking or alcohol consumption.
- 2.2. Entering under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 2.3. Use or possession of drugs, banned performance-enhancing substances, or narcotics.
- 2.4. Activities causing disturbance through noise, smell, or other environmental nuisances.
- 2.5. Bringing hazardous items, explosives, pyrotechnics, weapons, alcohol, or animals.
- 2.6. Without prior permission: commercial activities, advertising, propaganda, posting flyers or signs, making audio/video recordings, illegal gambling, or selling products.

3. Special Rules

- 3.1. Appropriate sportswear suitable for gym activities is required.
- 3.2. Clean, closed sports shoes must be worn at all times.
- 3.3. Only drinks in a sealed plastic bottle are allowed.
- 3.4. Users must maintain proper personal hygiene; otherwise, gym access will be denied.

3.5. At least two users must be present in the gym at the same time for safety reasons. Use is at your own risk.

4. General Rules

- 4.1. Maintain order, cleanliness, and respectful behaviour at all times.
- 4.2. Staff may remind users about appropriate attire and safe use of equipment.
- 4.3. Return machines to their default position and equipment to its designated storage place after use.
- 4.4. A towel must be used during training.
- 4.5. Use weight collars when working with adjustable weights.
- 4.6. Check equipment before use; report any faults immediately to raday.dorm@uni-corvinus.hu.
- 4.7. Residents under 18 may only use the gym with parental consent.
- 4.8. The gym is open daily from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
- 4.9. The porter unlocks the gym at 6:00 a.m. and locks it at 11:00 p.m.; please leave before closing.
- 4.10. The gym is closed for cleaning on Wednesdays from 10:00 to 11:00 a.m.
- 4.11. Observe the opening hours and leave in time for closing.
- 4.12. The gym fee must be paid in advance at the start of each academic semester.
- 4.13. The dormitory management may amend or supplement these rules at its discretion.

5. Liability

- 5.1. Corvinus University of Budapest is not responsible for personal injury or property damage resulting from failure to follow these rules, the Dormitory House Rules, or from negligent behaviour.
- 5.2. The university is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 5.3. Found items must be handed to the porter on duty for documentation.
- 5.4. All services and equipment are used at your own risk.

6. Emergencies

6.1. First aid is available at the porter's lodge. In case of injury, an accident report must be completed with the porter and the dormitory manager, operations manager, or senior helper on duty. Any extraordinary incident must be reported immediately to the porter. Depending on the situation, contact:

- **Ambulance** (accident): 104
- **Fire Department** (fire): 105
- **Police** (disturbance/theft): 107
- **General emergency**: 112

7. Misconduct

If a user violates these rules or generally accepted behaviour norms, they will first be warned. If the behaviour continues, dormitory staff, the porter, or the senior helper on duty may ask the user to leave and may suspend or revoke gym access. In serious cases, the police or relevant authorities may be called. Expelled users have no claim against the dormitory.
