Pannónia Grant for Double Degree Programmes

- Two equivalent diplomas in the same or nearly the same programme duration
- Bilateral agreement between institutions (4-5 students per year)
- Pre-established curriculum (automatic course recognition)
- 1,2 or 3 semester at the partner university
- Only Corvinus tuition to be paid or free: Corvinus Scholarship students
- Apply for Pannónia Scholarship

- 16 countries from CEE and Western Balkans
- Corvinus currently has 8 CEEPUS networks
- Open to: BSC, MSC PhD
- Activity: attendance, completion and crediting of courses is compulsory during the stay, and may be complemented by an internship
- Duration: 1 semester or trimester, 3-5 months,
- You can apply within a network or as a freemover

LONG-TERM STUDY MOBILITY

Minimum 60 – maximum 180 days

- Apply for 2026/2027 academic year
- Main application: 17 November 2025
- Second application: **ONLY** for 2027 Spring
- Only at partner universities
- **Excellence** scholarship: study at the **TOP 250** universities in the world



SHORT-TERM STUDY MOBILITY

- Min.2 – 30 days
- Application is continuous
- You can go for:
 - courses,
 - summer university,
 - study tour,
 - workshop,
 - competition,
 - conference.
- Could be: for credit acceptance OR without credit acceptance
- Partner universities and other places (letter of acceptance need)



INTERNSHIP

Min. 60 – max 120 day

- Available for all students (Bs, Ma, PhD, SH)
- Internship is possible after two completed semesters
- International semester can also be an internship
- Can be done during summer or educational break
- Possibility for internship after completing academic requirements (traineeship for recent graduates)
- Continuous application

Any places, partner (letter of acceptance need)



RESEARCH MOBILITY (only for PhD Students)

- Long-term research (min. 60 – max 150 days)
- Short-term research (min. 2 – max. 30 days)
- Partner universities or other places (letter of acceptance need)
- Letter of recommendation by the Head of Doctoral School
- Research and work plan

SHORT-TERM STUDY TOUR for GROUPS

- Min. 2 – max. 7 days study tour
- Organized by the professors for students registered to the course
- Counts to the given course as a professional study trip

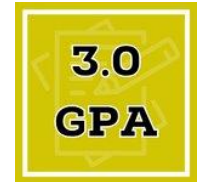

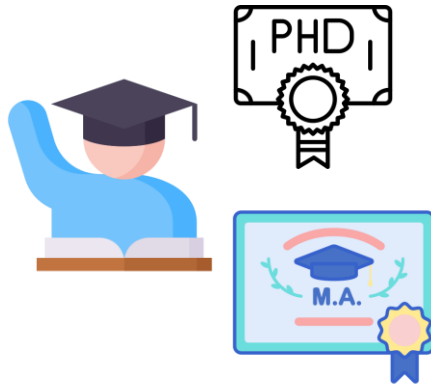

For Stipendium and Diaspora students

Language certificate requirements



- Language certificate min. B2 level
 - Students in programs taught in English will NOT have to upload B2 ENG certificates, but some host universities may require it –student’s responsibility to check
 - Students in programs taught in Hungarian will have to upload B2 ENG certificates
 - Language certificates **do not have to be valid at the time of the application, BUT!**
- The host university may **require VALID language** certificate. If so, then you have to do it until their deadline or your mobility
- Or may require certification of higher level or other language (C1)

If mobility is canceled by the partner due to missing the language requirement, it will be the responsibility of the applicant!

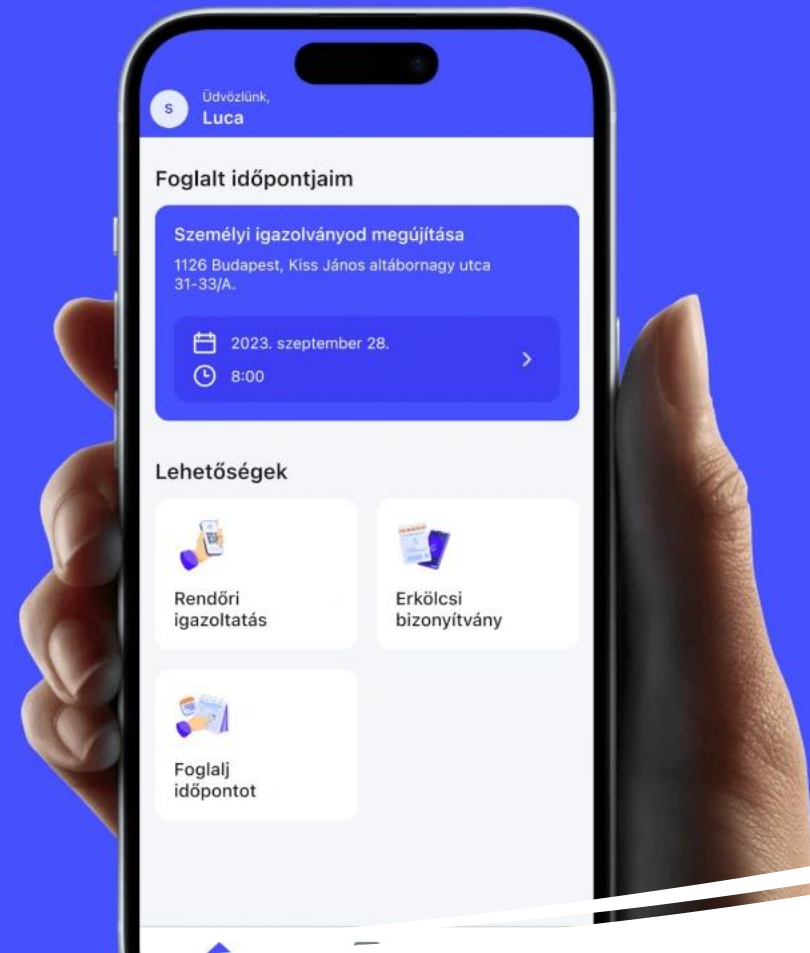

What could possibly go wrong?

- Min. 21 credits, max. 30 credits or 6 subjects
- Apply for a discipline that your program allows (you may see both MSC and BSC in Neptun)
- Are there enough English courses? Or just Spanish or
- Does the language certificate of the host university have to be **VALID** ??
- When attaching application attachments, make sure to upload the entire document – uploading a certificate insert is **NOT** enough
- Choice of specialization: specializations are for Spring OR Fall – check conflict!
- Do NOT use special characters or accented letters in the names of attached application files

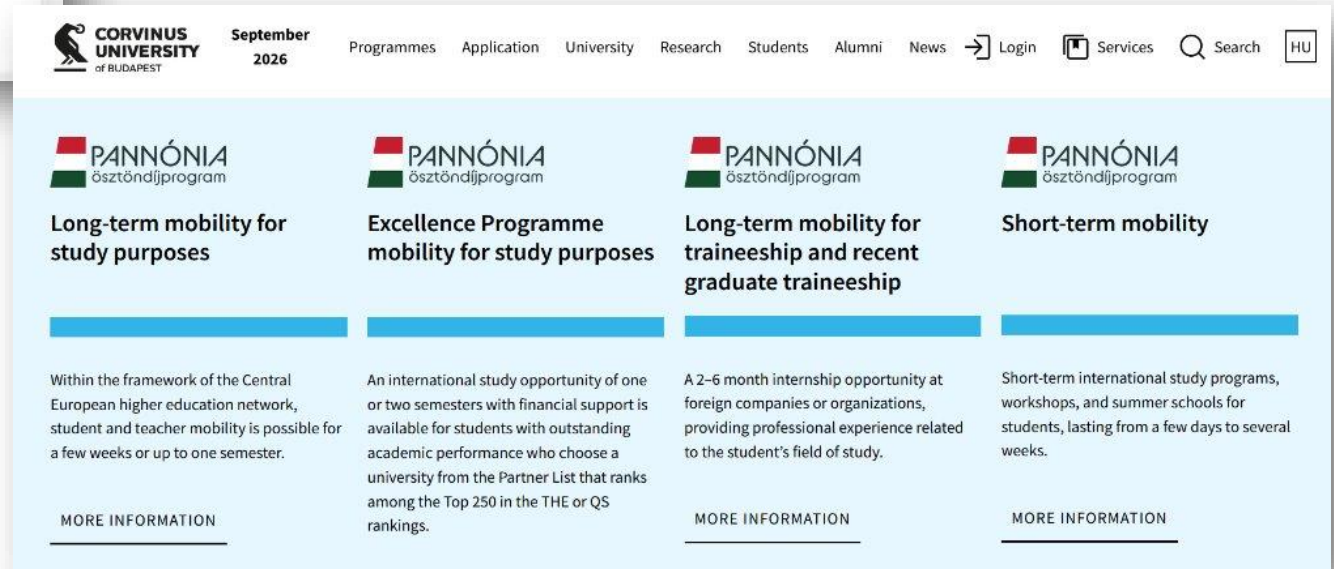
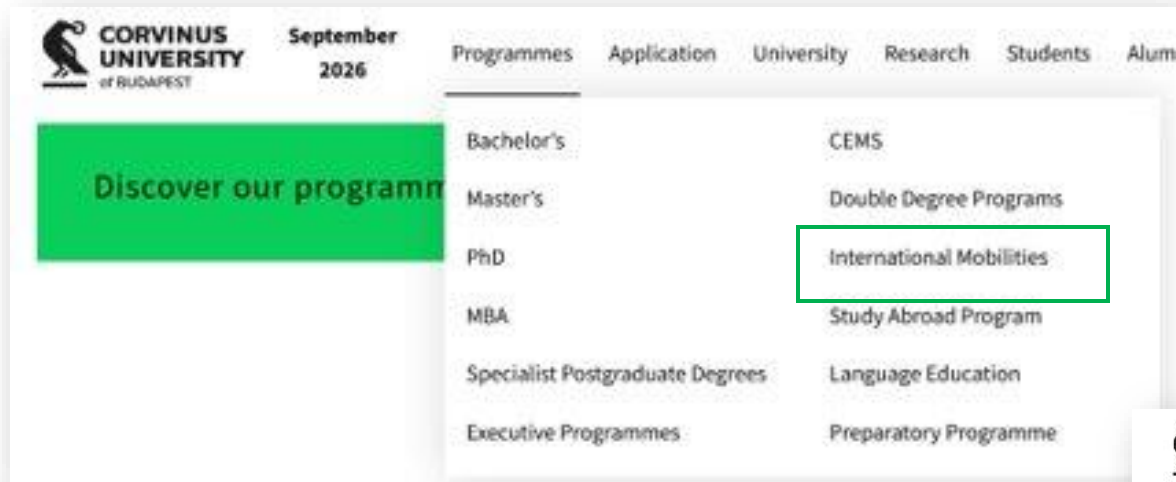
