Short Description of the Exam	Admission interview: assess and evaluate applicants' professional preparation (40% expertise: competent answers to the questions about compulsory and chosen literature), motivation (30% well-informed about the university and the degree programme, realistic assessment of the resources and plans), aptitude (30% professional skills e.g. problem sensitivity, reasoning and communication skills, and professional linguistic competence)
Tools Allowed During the Exam	Nothing.
Recommended Literature	Required literature: Kahneman, D. (2011). Thinking, fast and slow. Macmillan
Exam Topics	Ability to pose, apply and/or answer dilemmas and problems based on a critical analysis of the compulsory literature.
Sample Questions / Example Tasks	Give an example of a given behavioral and decision-making characteristic discussed in the literature (topics: two systems, heuristics, biases, overconfidence, choices).
