Our key organisational goals align with the key strategic objectives of Corvinus University's fine-tuned "Bridge strategy" are the following

Operational excellence

- Meeting the criteria of the *Library Quality Award* title
 - Developing and implementing an action plan based on the notes taken on the "Areas for development" and "Recommendations for action" of the organizational self-evaluation survey, in conjunction with the expert review taken in the frame of application of the Library Quality Award.
- Preparation for the transition to the international metadata standard of *Marc 21*: we plan to perform data cleansing of 100.000 records in the HunTéka integrated library system
- Review of the retrospective collection-management process, implementing a comprehensive, multi-year schedule
- Ensuring the preservation and accessibility of the University's historically significant documents, creating a metadata structure based on document types, and devising and scheduling a digitization strategy
- Assessment of our communication channels, implementation of a communication strategy
- Initiation of a PR team for enhancing the Library's society and its institutional and professional relationships

Tram 2: a multidisciplinary university

- Developing the First Year Seminar course's information literacy and library transversal skills modules
- Acquiring and providing information on Open Educational Resources
- Enhancing researchers' competencies and their amplifying effects with/by
 - Promoting the transversal skills development trainings of the Library, and organising events to inform the professors
 - Supporting the University's internal training policy, and engaging in the implementation of training modules that support teaching excellence

- Supporting EQUIS accreditation with publication data
- Implementing services that support student integration:
 - City vibes shelves and exhibition in cooperation with Corvinus Art Academy
 - Creating and managing the collection at the Gellért reading room

InterCity: a student-focused university

- Partial renovation of the library's physical and service infrastructure by creating spaces and operating services aligned with and reflecting to the students' needs
- Creating training contents that support individual learning paths, extending our e-learning material, and providing content in English language
- Launching a bibliotherapy programme series to support student well-being
- Participation in the organisation of Campus tours
- Participation in the project of the University Student Hub to improve accessibility to the training materials
- Initiation of a UX project for monitoring our users' habits regarding the new infrastructure to build them into our services

The ring: a research-based university

- Organising workshops for the young researchers in collaboration with the Doctoral Student Council
- Presenting publications and research activities associated with the University, enhancing science communication content
- Assisting in the review of the Academic Career Path through preparation and compilation of the relevant journal lists
- Improving the efficiency of the compilation of publication data and metrics related to the Academic Career Path and other promotions
- Technical update of platforms and software (OJS, OMP) facilitating online access to the University's publications (journals, books, and other documents), along with the expansion of associated services
- Managing case studies affiliated with Corvinus University, establishing a platform for dissemination
- Examination of the Archive's materials, handover and cataloguing of books
