

DATA PROCESSING NOTICE CONCERNING DATA PROCESSING IN CONNECTION
WITH THE REGISTRATION FOR DSG EVENTS AT THE CORVINUS UNIVERSITY OF

2. LEGISLATION ON WHICH THE DATA PROCESSING IS BASED

- Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (of 27 April 2016) on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation /hereinafter: GDPR/),
- Act CXII of 2011 on the Right of Informational Self-Determination and on Freedom of Information

3. SCOPE OF DATA PROCESSED AND THE PURPOSE, LEGAL GROUNDS AND DURATION OF DATA PROCESSING

SCOPE OF POSSIBLE PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED:

First name(s), last name(s), title (if applicable), e-mail address, affiliated institute(s), position(s), postcode of departure for estimating CO₂ emissions, transport mode for estimating CO₂ emissions, eating preference, food allergy, consent to photos and videos.

PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING:

In the case of the data listed previously, the organisation and conduct of the event and communication (networking) with the data subject.

LEGAL GROUND OF DATA PROCESSING:

For all data, the consent of the data subject pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR and, for the indicated dietary attributes, Article 9(2)(a) of the GDPR.

DURATION OF DATA PROCESSING:

All data will be processed by CORVINUS until the end of the organisation of the subsequent identical DSG event.

DATA SUBJECT:

Natural persons registering for the particular DSG event at the University.

SOURCE OF DATA:

The data are provided to CORVINUS by the data subjects themselves during online registration.

4. ACCESS TO THE DATA, TRANSFER OF THE DATA

The data are only accessible to CORVINUS employees involved in the registration and the conduct of the event to the extent and for the duration strictly necessary for the performance of their duties. CORVINUS only discloses data to third parties on the basis of a legal authorisation or with the consent of the data subject.

CORVINUS hereby informs participants that photographs and video recordings will be taken at the DSG events for the purpose of capturing, documenting, and promoting the DSG events, and that CORVINUS will share these on its social media platforms.

If the data subject does not wish to be photographed or have his/her images used by CORVINUS as described above, the data subject is asked to choose a photo-free zone at the particular DSG event or inform the photographer (István Bielik, istvanbielik@gmail.com, +36-20-226-4074) on site of his/her request.

5. DATA SECURITY MEASURES

CORVINUS will take all data security (organisational and IT) measures to ensure the protection of data in proportion to the real risks involved.

6. RIGHTS IN RELATION TO DATA PROCESSING

The data subject has the right to request information about the data processing, the right to request the rectification of the data, the right to object to the data processing, the right to request restriction of the processing and the right to request that CORVINUS make his/her personal data and the information relating to their processing available to him/her. The data subject has the right to withdraw his/her consent under this Notice at any time, which also means that if the consent is withdrawn before the event takes place, the data subject loses his/her right to participate in the event. The lawfulness of data processing prior to the withdrawal of consent is not affected by the withdrawal of consent.

7. ENFORCEMENT OF RIGHTS IN RELATION TO DATA PROCESSING

In exercising the rights of control under Point 6, the data subject may turn to the CORVINUS Data Protection Officer, the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (NAIH) or to a court.
