

Information on the Extension of the Corvinus Scholarship Support/Eligibility Period 2025/26/2

Dear Student,

If, in your current degree program,

- a) you **will have used up** the maximum number of **semesters eligible for the Corvinus Scholarship** by the end of the 2025/26/2 semester (which corresponds to the duration of your degree program) AND
- b) you have participated in a study abroad program, as documented in Neptun, then pursuant to Section 25(13) of the Student Tuition and Benefits Regulations (RSFB), **you may receive Corvinus scholarship support for an additional 1 semester**, provided that
- c) by the end of the 2025/26/2 semester, **no later than June 28, 2026**, you submit the application titled ***M401-Request for extension of semesters supported by a Corvinus scholarship*** through the Neptun system.
- d) You must attach the transcript issued by the foreign institution to the application.

If you do not submit the application by the above deadline, you will only be able to complete your studies in the semester beyond the standard program duration on a self-funded basis.

Please also note that

- a) you must not exceed the Corvinus scholarship's **eligibility period** (the maximum combined number of active and passive semesters), during which you may receive Corvinus scholarship support. This period is the duration of your program plus 1 semester; for undivided master's programs, it is plus 2 semesters.
- b) If you wish to receive the Corvinus scholarship in a semester beyond your eligibility period, you must (also) submit the application titled ***M501-Request for extension of the Corvinus scholarship eligibility period*** via the Neptun system at **no later than June 28, 2026, 28 at the latest, if the eligibility period for your program ends in the 2025/26/2 semester** and you meet the conditions described in Section 25(15) of the RSFB.

If you are already registered as a student with a disability in the Neptun system prior to the 2025/26/2 semester, you do not need to submit the above applications. As a registered student, the number of semesters supported by the Corvinus scholarship is +1 semester for bachelor's and split master's programs, and +2

semesters for undivided master's programs; the eligibility period is twice the duration of your program.
