1. Name of the training: ESG consultant M

2. Name of the programme in the micro-credential: ESG Consultant

3. Admission shall be subject to: The ESG consultant training is open to persons with a bachelor's (formerly bachelor's) or master's degree and diploma in a specialised field of study, in accordance with the NGM Decree 30/2024 (VIII. 8.).

4. Procedure for the evaluation of applications

The competent Dean shall decide on admission applications, subject to the available capacity and admission requirements, while taking into consideration the specific provisions governing specialized knowledge programmes established under the applicable sectoral legislation.

5. Contact hours of the programme: 240 contact hours plus one month of professional practice. The programme is delivered 80% in person.

6. Number of credits to be accumulated for the qualification: 36 ECTS credits

7. The competences, knowledge elements, skills, personal aptitudes and abilities to be acquired during the programme, the application of the qualification in a concrete context, in a system of activities:

According to the NGM Decree 30/2024 (VIII.8.) "the client training ESG consultants shall ensure during the training that the trainee is able to, after the training

- use the theories and methods learnt, to discover, organise and analyse facts and basic relationships, to draw independent conclusions, make critical comments, prepare proposals for decisions, and make decisions in routine and partly unfamiliar national and international contexts;
- follow and interpret global economic and international business trends, changes in economic policy and related policies and legislation relevant to the field, their effects, and take them into account in their analyses, proposals and decisions;
- determine the complex consequences of economic processes, business organisational processes and events, and to assess legal compliance;
- provide ESG-related corporate governance expertise and ESG data related information and advisory services;
- complete due diligence on the business for sustainability and collect data on the whole value chain;
- collect and analyse data on sustainability issues, prepare corporate social responsibility and ESG strategies, and implement rules on risk management, risk analysis and preventive measures;
- define and manage the professional tasks necessary for the adaptation of the ESG requirements framework, to coordinate the cooperation between the departments involved, to prepare and effectively implement the responsible professional decisions and to involve the appropriate experts;
- prepare an ESG report independently.

8. The programme concludes with an exam.
